INTRODUCTION

Please read and understand all instructions in this manual carefully and thoroughly before attempting to operate this product. These instructions contain important safety and use information.

UNPACKING

The products in this kit have been thoroughly tested and have been shipped in perfect operating condition. Carefully check the shipping carton for damage that may have occurred during shipping. If the carton appears to be damaged, carefully inspect each unit included for damage and be sure all accessories necessary to operate the units have arrived intact. In the event damage has been found or parts are missing, please contact our customer support team for further instructions. Please do not return this kit to your dealer without first contacting customer support at the number listed below. Please do not discard the shipping carton in the trash. Please recycle whenever possible.

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LIMITED WARRANTY (USA ONLY)

1. Elation Professional hereby warrants, to the original purchaser, Elation Professional products to be free of manufacturing defects in material and workmanship for a period of two years (730 days), and Elation Professional product rechargeable batteries to be free of manufacturing defects in material and workmanship for a period of six months (180 days), from the original date of purchase. This warranty excludes discharge lamps and all product accessories. This warranty shall be valid only if the product is purchased within the United States of America, including possessions and territories. 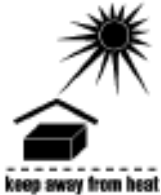

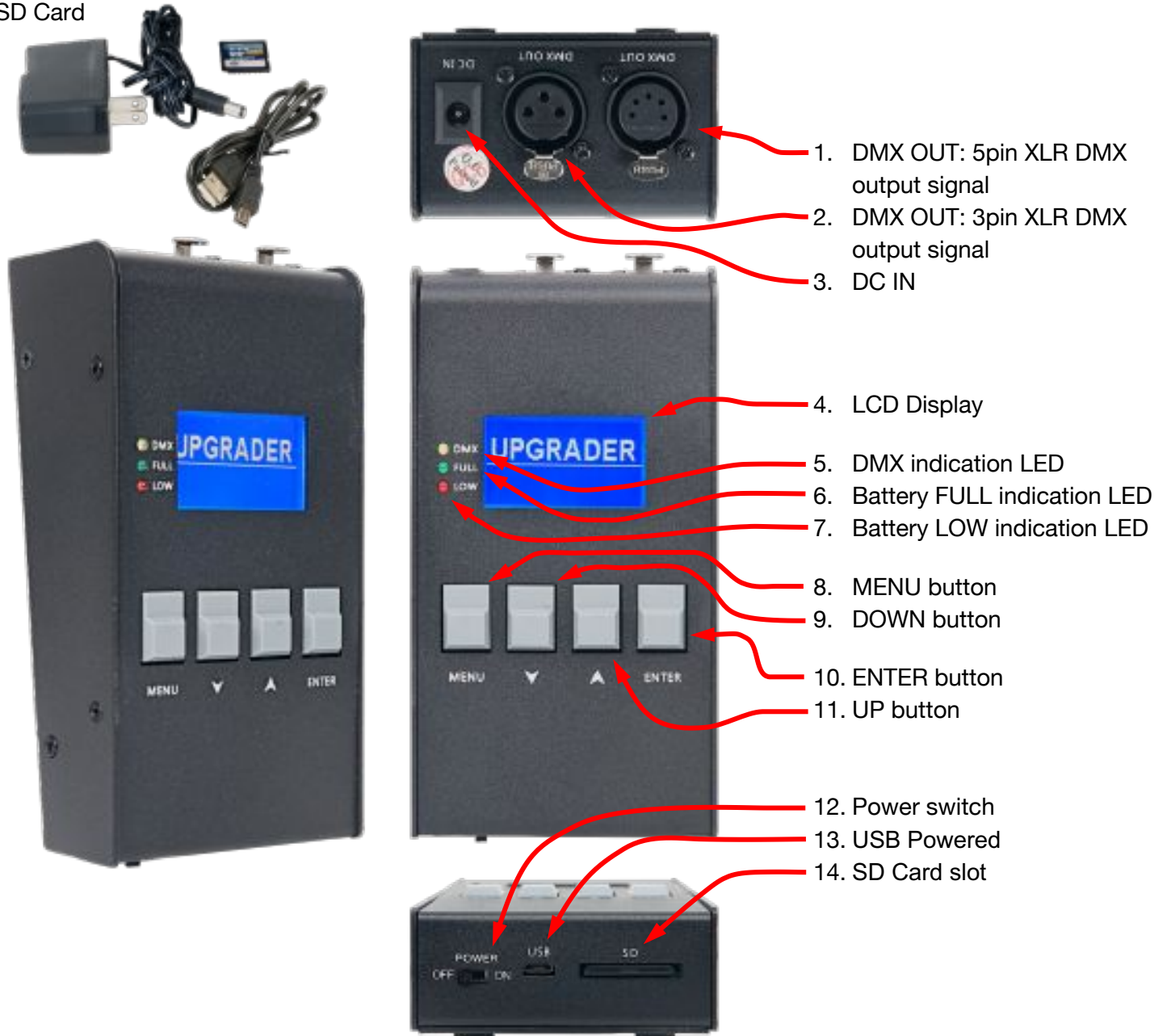

OVERVIEW

The SNI Software Uploader™ is a battery powered hand held software uploader used to update Elation compatible lighting fixtures. Easily upload a software update to an Elation lighting fixture by connecting the uploader to the fixture using a 3pin or 5pin DMX cable (not included). Elation software updates (not included) are stored on a MICRO SD card (included) and inserted into the uploader. SNI Software Uploader™ features an LCD display, 4 push button control panel, a MICRO SD card slot, 3pin and 5pin XLR DMX outputs, an On/Off switch, and includes a 12VDC external power supply, USB cable, and blank MICRO SD card.

OPERATION



1. With software update stored on MICRO SD card (included), insert SD card into SD card slot.
2. Connect **SNI Software Uploader** to fixture using 3pin or 5pin DMX cable (not included) to fixture. If you want to upload more than one at a time, daisy chain them with DMX cables.
3. With the fixture connected, power the **SNI Software Uploader**.




4. With DMX cable connected to fixture, power **SNI Software Uploader**. Use down▼/up▲ arrow buttons to choose between **Firmware Upgrade** and **Fixture Information**. Select **Firmware Upgrade** and press **ENTER**.





5. Select your fixture and press **ENTER**, then select the first **V00** file to be upgraded and press **ENTER**. Power your fixture(s).



Update Load

6. The yellow DMX indicator LED lights up when a pop-up menu displays **Fast Speed** and **Slow Speed**. Choose desired speed of upgrade and press **ENTER**. The fixture screen should display **Update Load**, and once the process has begun, will briefly display the various elements being upgraded.

7. The **SNI Software Uploader** will display the upgrade process from 0-100%. The yellow DMX indicator LED stays lit until it reaches 100%. Once the first “**V00**” file upgrade is complete, the upgrade process will display **100% OK!**, and the DMX indicator LED shuts off.

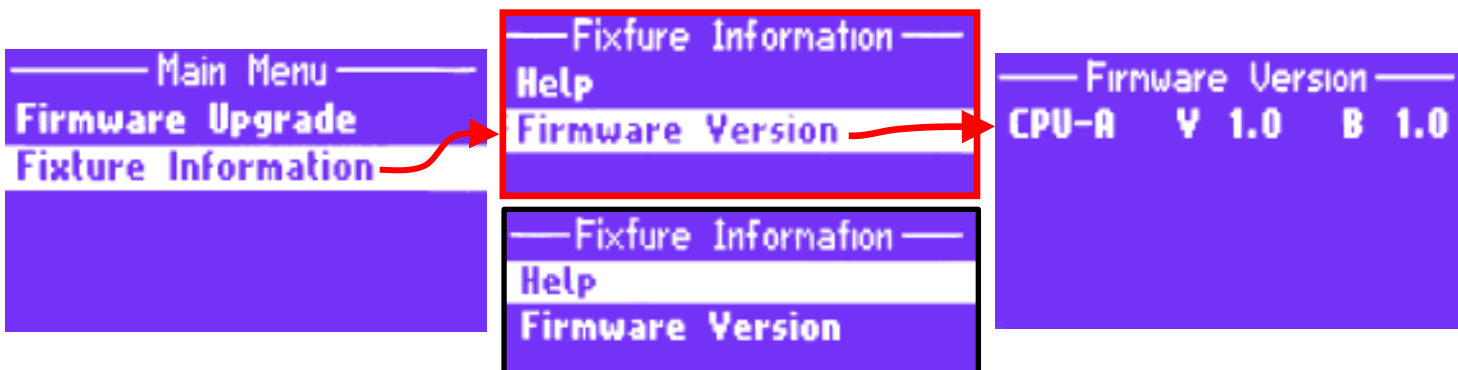

8. While still in the Firmware Upgrade screen, pressing **MENU** once returns you to the upgrade file screen. Select the next upgrade file and press **ENTER**, again select the desired speed and press **ENTER**, which again displays the upgrade process from 0-100%.



9. Again, the upgrade process displays from 0-100%. Continue this with all subsequent upgrade files until complete.



10. To display the **Firmware Version**, select **Fixture Information** and press **ENTER**, then select **Firmware Version** and **ENTER**. Selecting **Help** doesn't perform any function.

11. On a typical fixture, press the **MENU** button, scroll down to **Factory Setting**, press **ENTER**, select **YES** and press **ENTER** to perform the factory defaults. Restart your fixture.

RECHARGING INTERNAL BATTERY
